NEW this year will be an inclusive system of scheduling which will allow multi-sport athletes to participate in both spring high school sports AND FSC club soccer.

FSC recognizes the need for schedule flexibility in order for athletes to represent their schools in the spring while also playing and developing as soccer players at the club level. To this end, FSC will be instituting player-centered programming which will focus on the individual needs of players while minimizing or eliminating schedule conflicts with winter and spring sports. This programming will be tailored to each team and will be decided upon by the team coach and Director of Coaching. The overall objective will be to create an environment in which maximum participation can be achieved through planning which accounts for the number of multi-sport athletes on each team and what the schedules of those sports will be. In short, FSC does not want student athletes to be forced to choose between spring school sports and spring club soccer. We believe student athletes can do both and through this new programming it will be made possible. Options for structuring this environment may include:

- **League Play in either Montana or Washington leagues**
- **Tournaments to compliment league play**
- **Tournament only schedule with friendly matches scheduled for consistent games**
- **Expanded rosters to allow multi-sport athletes to attend most but not all events**
- **All activities are tailored to minimize conflicts with high school sports and allow for maximum participation for all soccer players.**
